

- 1. Alien Ear Monitors require a full impression and must include the crus of the helix, antitragus and tragus (just passing the second bend of the ear canal)
- 2. Foam or cotton ear dams are fine
- 3. Impressions should be open mouth (using a bite block) if the client is singing or makes faces on stage while using the monitors/molds please have them mimic these facial expressions while the impression material is in the ears.
- 4. Please put plenty of backing impression material on the impressions (i.e Frankenstien bolts!!!)
